To be considered, applicants must submit:

- A personal statement of 300-500 words discussing their interest in instruction librarianship
- A current CV or resume

The chosen candidate will have the option to either

- Present a 5 minute "lightning talk" on instruction from the student perspective at SCIL Works
- Write a 300 word essay about the experience of attending SCIL Works to be featured in the SCIL Newsletter
